Instruction for trash disposal and trash/recycling pick up schedule

- Trash disposal is located to the left of the Airbnb parking spots, behind Riff Raff Brewing Company. The trash dumpster is the one on the left, cardboard recycling is located on the right. Dumpsters are emptied on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

Location of fire extinguisher(s)

- Wall across from kitchen.

Evacuation instructions in the event of fire or other emergency

- In the event of a fire, please utilize the main entrance of the unit and evacuate down the stairs into the parking lot and alley behind the building.

Town noise restrictions

- It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or permit to be operated a source of noise which creates a sound pressure level average (LAeq) that exceeds the limits set forth in [Max Permissible Levels located below) for any measurement period. The measurement period shall not be less than three (3) minutes and shall be measured at the approximate property boundary of the property affected by the noise. When a noise source can be identified and its noise is measured in more than one (1) zoning district, the applicable limits of each zoning district shall apply within such district. Noise levels for any overlay district shall conform with Table I and shall be determined according to the base zoning district.

Snow removal information

- Snow shovels are provided for the unit if snow removal is needed.
- Snow removal is provided by the host and will be done as often as necessary. The parking lot has a contract snow removal provider who will clear the lot by 11 am after a storm.

Location for on-site parking of vehicles and the maximum # of parked vehicles permitted.

- We provide one marked parking slot that can fit two vehicles in tandem for the apartment in the back alley side of the Riff Raff Brewing Company building. Pull around the back of the building and you will see the parking space designated for Unit D.
- You may park across the alley in the spots not designated for guests in the Lewis Street Hideout.
- You may park on the adjacent streets of Lewis and US 160 and no permit is required.

Max # of people permitted to sleep in the licensed premises

- 8 people max

Leash Law

Dogs shall be kept under control by their Owners at all times. (CO 4.1)

- On a leash of sufficient strength to restrain the dog.
- Confined in a building, fence or other structure in such a way that he does not escape. Or is on property possessed by its owner.
- The dog is to be within sight and hearing distance of its owner, keeper or family member, who upon command can call dog within a distance of four feet of such person.

Smoking policy

- No smoking of any substances, including but not limited to cigarettes, e-cigarettes and vapes, cigars, and marijuana, are allowed in the unit.

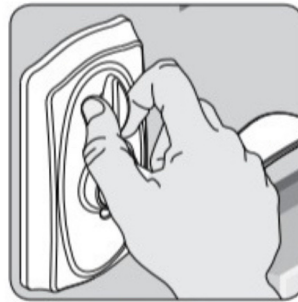
FAQS

LAUNDRY

 - for unlock to be enabled turn the interior knob straight up and down
 - to enable the door to lock, turn the interior knob side to side.

WHERE TO WALK PETS ...or JUST TAKE A WALK

There is a park, called Town Park, across the street (US 160) from your location that has access to the riverwalk trail.

The trail is 2 miles along and will take you near natural hot springs in the river, as well as The Hot Springs Resort down to the Ross Aragon Community Center.

There's an opportunity to see the geothermal green houses, amphitheater, and community gardens, grab coffee at one of the local coffee shops, and even fish, swim, tube, or just dip your toes in the San Juan River along the way.

From late Fall through late Spring the activities don't change much except instead of playing in the river, locals can be found hitting the fresh pow up at Wolf Creek Ski Area or taking advantage of well-maintained Cross Country Ski tracks.
